Watching videos GPS/navigational displays are allowed



Recording or streaming video

EXCEPTIONS

Some notable exceptions include:

- Reporting an emergency
- First responders in official duties
- Utility workers in emergencies and outages
- Drivers holding phone to ear for conversations
- Drivers stopped at traffic light or parked on a road for emergency or closure




