

Agreement

Whereas, Adams Township and Pleasant Township (Townships) are finalizing a contract for the procurement of ambulance services from Fisher-Titus Affiliated Services.

Whereas, this contract includes a significant price increase for the Townships from the existing contract.


Whereas, Seneca County (County) is working with various local governmental entities on the provision of ambulance services and desire to aid and assist the Townships with the Fisher-Titus Affiliated Services contract.

Wherefore, the Townships and County agree as follows:


1. The Townships will enter into the contract with Fisher-Titus Affiliated Services to commence on or near July 1, 2021.
2. The County will pay the Townships the following sums to be applied towards the Fisher-Titus Affiliated Services Contract:
 - a. 7/1/21-6/30/22: \$40,000
 - b. 7/1/22-6/30/23: \$45,000
 - c. 7/1/23-6/30/24: \$50,000
3. The County shall pay the annual amount on or before July 1 of each contract year. *The County may pre-pay any or all of the years at its absolute and total discretion.*
4. If the contract with Fisher-Titus Affiliated Services ends for any reason, the obligation of the County for payments made pursuant to this Agreement will terminate. The County is entitled to recover any amount prepaid on a pro-rata basis.
5. This Agreement has been prepared by the Seneca County Prosecuting Attorney as a scrivener for all parties. As legal counsel for Adams Township, Pleasant Township, and Seneca County no client secrets have or should be shared with the Seneca County Prosecuting Attorney as no confidentiality may be maintained from the other entities. If any of the parties hereto want or need independent legal advice, that party should undertake to secure independent legal counsel.




